HUANCAYO

The city of Huancayo is located at 3249 masl in the Mantaro Valley, on the central part of Peruvian Andes. It is the capital city of the Department of Junín, and it is considered one of the most prosperous cities of Peruvian highlands because of its commercial activity and its colonial heritage. It is known for its natural landscapes, its tourist attractions, and for having one of the tastiest gastronomies of the region

CITY TOUR AND COCHAS

Visit to the **Identidad Huanca Park** (entirely built-in stones), **Cerrito de La Libertad** from where you can see panoramic views of the city and the valley, the **old Cathedral** and **Constitution Square**, finishing at **Cochas**, place where great artisans made the famous *mate burilado* (traditional Peruvian dry pumpkin) handmade carved with traditional leitmotifs.

OCOPA CONVENT AND INGENIO VALLEY **L**

The **Ocopa Convent** was built two centuries ago, with his Missionary Museum and his Library with over 20 thousand books. It has on his walls some of the most important religious works' arts on the continent and a valuable collection of paintings of the Cusco School.

The **Ingenio Valley** is a place with an amazing natural beauty where the largest Trout Farm has been built there.

CITY TOUR AND COCHAS, PACA LAGOON AND JAUJA **L**

After the city tour and Cochas, visit to the **Paca Lagoon** with peaceful waters where you can take a relaxing ride on boat and then go to the city of **Jauja** to visit the main square, the Cathedral and the Cristo Pobre Chapel.



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HUAYTAPALLANA GLACIER

The **Huaytapallana Glacier** is located at 25 Km. from the city. It is a glacier with perpetual snow with an altitude of over 5000 masl. During the journey, you would be able to see Vilcacoto, from where the face of the Laya (an ancient priest) can be visualized from the rocky formations of the mountains. Afterwards, Chamiseria (a Quechua landscape), Pachapata (waterfalls) and the former farm of Acopalca, can be also seen.

TRADITIONAL CIRCUIT

Visit to the **artisan centres of Hualhuas** (stands out for the elaboration of specialized weaving of alpaca and sheep wool) and **San Jerónimo** (known for its excellent jewelers qualified in silverwork and fine jewelry). Then, we will visit the **Ocopa Convent**, the **Ingenio Valley** and the **city of Jauja**.

ARCHAEOLOGICAL CIRCUIT

Visit to **Warivilca Temple**, considered as the worship place of the inhabitants of the Wari Culture; **Chongos Bajo**, an ancient and picturesque town which church has altars carved in baroque style and paintings from Cusco School. In this place we can locate a stone cross called Cani Cruz, considered as the most ancient one in the country. Then we proceed to see archaeological pre-Inca rests of **Arwaturo** from where you will have a view of Ñahuinpuquio Lagoon.

HIGHLAND JUNGLE CIRCUIT

Visit to the cities of **Tarma**, to the the Santuario of Muruhuay and the Main Square, **San Ramón** and the Tirol waterfalls (45-minute hike), **La Merced** to visit the Main Square, Kimiri suspension bridge, and Reiter bridge. After the lunch, visit to the **butterfly farm**, the **Pampa Michi native community** and a **coffee processor plant**. Return to Huancayo.
