Piura is always sunny, and its sky is always blue; a place where the soul of the desert and the light of the tropics make it unique in South America. Its beaches have sands ranging from yellowish to orange colors and are surrounded by algarrobos and tropical savannah. The ocean is greenish turquoise; its temperature is lukewarm (an average of 24°C) and varied. It is worldwide famous because of beaches like Máncora, Los Órganos and Cabo Blanco. The latter is where in 1953 Alfred Glassell Jr. fished the world's largest black merlin, which weighed 1560 pounds according to IGFA. The beaches are great for surfing and deep-water fishing.

HUMPBACK WHALES WATCHING

Through the months of July up to the month of November, whale watching is available to observe the humpback whales that arrive from the Antarctic waters to the North Shore of Peru to mate and raise their calves. During the tour, you will be able to see these magnificent cetaceans making extraordinary leaps. There is also the possibility of seeing the common dolphin, sea lions, turtles, blue-footed boobies, etc.
