TUMBES

Tumbes is a city located on the northwest end of Peru. It is the capital of the province and department of Tumbes, and it is near the Tumbes River delta at the Guayaquil Gulf (Pacific Ocean), which is 30 Km. away from the boundary with Ecuador. Due to its tropical savannah geographical location, its weather is warm and humid during the entire year, its annual average temperature is 27C.

PUNTA SAL

It is a small bathing resort with good hotel facilities. The surface of its beaches is very irregular, and its high tide reaches the border of the houses located south of the resort. During low tide fine sand beaches appear.

Because of its location, Punta Sal is blessed with sun throughout the year. Its water is warm, generally exceeding 20°C. It is near the distribution limits of the Tropical East Pacific region, which keeps a great diversity of tropical fauna.
